

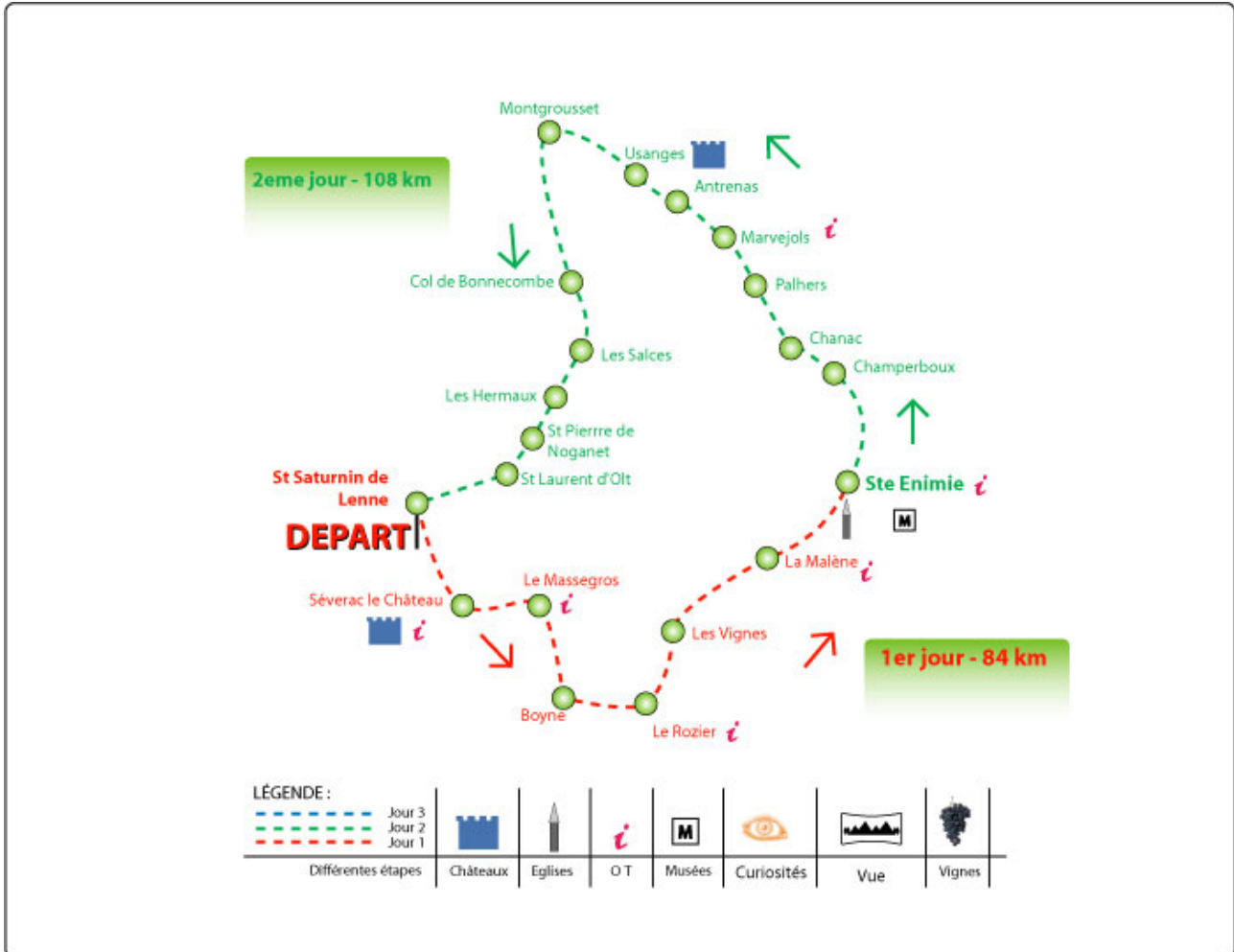


From the gorges of the Tarn river to the Monts d'Aubrac Circuit N°17



From the depths of the Gorges of Tarn to the summit of the Causses this itinerary will reveal a succession of towns and medieval castles in dream panoramas.

<i>The travel book recommend the number of minimum days which can be devoted to the itinerary.</i>



Enjoy a stopover in the time and space from Niaux grotto to the Space Museum in Toulouse, discover this vast region, a land of vineyard and sun providing multiple resources.

Wines : Cahors, Madiran, Gaillac, Pacherenc, côtes du Frontonnais, Côtes de St Mont.

Local Produce/Gastronomy : armagnac, goose preserves, cassoulet, duck, foie gras, ceps, truffles, beans tarbais, tripes, aligot, garbure, cheeses (roquefort, laguiole, Rocamadour, bleu des Causses, moulis, tomme des Pyrénées), pink garlic from Lautrec, chasselas de Moissac, saussage from Toulouse, melon from Quercy.

Traditional Handicraft : Laguiole knives, gloves from Millau, furniture of art from Revel, hats from Caussade, Pewters from Grammat and Rouergue, Coppers from Durfort, horn combs from Lavelanet.

1 Day 1 :

A genuine village of farmers will be the starting point of your journey. You will stay in the quietness of a vast home the Saint-Saturnin castle.

Further to your departure you will approach the wild panoramas of the Causse de Séverac which undulate for ever and ever. From time to time you will distinguish a few helmets and their slated roofs as well as shelters for the shepherds.

The town of Séverac lies on the sides of an isolated hill in the distance. It is towered by an imposing rock supporting the ruins of the castle belong to one of the oldest Baron estate in France.

Then you will, travel towards the limestone plateau of the Causse de Sauveterre and its uneven landscapes. At Massegros you will discover superb Araganoise houses at the heart of a Causse village.

After the crossing of the Causse punctuated with views you will travel down towards the Rozier village built at the confluence of the rivers Tarn and Joute and starting point for the circuit of the Gorges of Tarn.

The opened up road on the right bank of the river Tarn is particularly scenic. Actually the gorges reveal a large amount of typical sites, helmets hanged on the rock, ruins of castles or restored castles, villages harbouring a Roman church and old houses standing along side streets.

The end of the journey will lead you to Sainte-Enimie after having crossed the villages of Vignes and Malène.

2 Day 2 :

After a night in a castle of legend at the heart of an unforgettable panorama in the Gorges of Tarn, you will leave Sainte-Enimie and the Caze castle with some regret to travel towards the limestone plateau of the Causse de Sauveterre.

You will cross Champerboux one of the rare helmet on this wild plateau where the Causse habitat is remarkable. Until Champerboux, you will only meet shelters for shepherd made of dry stones.

You will reach the pretty valley of Colagne where Marvejols is nestled. The town has kept three fortified doors from the beginning of the XVIIIth century and houses with superb façades and wrought-iron balconies.

On leaving Marvejols you will reach the slopes of the des Mounts of Aubrac. The old and beautiful villages Aubrac, sometimes hidden away from the road enable the visitor to discover a genuine architecture. You will drive fairly near from the Baume castle, nicknamed "le Versailles du Guévaudan", one of the most beautiful castle in Lozère.

After Montgrousset fairly near the Déroc cave and the waterfall the road rises towards the wild lake area.

At more than 1000 metre of elevation the dark and deep Salhiens lake, the peaceful lake of Souverols, Saint-Andéol and Born lakes provide a protected and magical setting. In Bonnetombe pass at 1361 metres of elevation The road rises at its highest point revealing a superb panorama.

before driving down towards the Lot and Saint-Saturnin-de-Lenne valley, do stop at the Salces and visit the church, a fully restored masterpiece of the Auvergnat Roman art.
